From the Principal

Welcome back to our returning families and welcome to the Day School to our new families.

Our school year is off to a great start! We have had very few tears. Children are adjusting beautifully. If you have any questions or concerns, please call or stop by my office. My door is always open. We are quite busy at the start of the year, so if you call and get the machine, please leave a message and Pam or I will be sure to call you back.

If you come into the school to drop off or pick up your child(ren) please remember to sign them in/out at the office. You must also check in and get a nametag if you

visit the school for any reason.



When you drive up to the gate for drop off or pick up please pull up to the white post on the fence or right behind the person in front of you. We are trying to load/unload three cars at a time.

Drop off for the five-day programs is at 8:20. Children in the three-day programs should not arrive until 8:45. If you arrive during the earlier carpool time, you will be asked to come back at 8:45. Two-day classes come at 9:30/1:30 until October 2nd when they start coming at 8:45/12:45.

Speaking of carpool, the first few days of school the morning carpool line was unbearably long. Because of

this I changed the pick up time of the five day program to 11:45. This made a huge difference in the line. **Tiger Sharks** should be picked up 11:45-11:50.

Tuesday/Thursday afternoons we only have 16 students to dismiss so please come between 3:25-3:35.

If Marlboro Street is full, please loop around the block and come back. Police take notice and do not want cars blocking High Street.

There was an error in the school calendar. Martin Luther King Day is Jan. 21st not the 14th. Please mark your calendar as a no school day.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. *What are you doing about the mosquito problem?*

We will not apply bug spray unless you ask us to do so or we see an apparent need to do so. Do not assume if you sign the permission form that we will automatically apply spray.
